Created in 1839, Arnos Vale Cemetery is a peaceful Victorian garden cemetery. It's a unique place where remembrance, nature, history, and community come together.

Traditional burials

A traditional burial is the interment of a coffin into an earthen grave.

This type of burial site can be used for up to two burials and between two and four sets of ashes.

A traditional memorial headstone with stone kerbs and a vase, that is in keeping with the current historical monuments and surroundings, can be placed to memorialise a loved one. Together, these elements create a dignified and meaningful tribute to those who have passed, becoming a lasting place of remembrance, where loved ones can visit, reflect, and honour a life lived.

Natural burials

Natural woodland burial is the choice to be buried in an environmentally friendly woodland setting rather than a traditional cemetery grave. It's an eco-conscious way to bury your loved ones in a natural, peaceful setting.

The Arnos Vale Natural Burial Woodland is situated at the top of Arnos Vale cemetery adjacent to Arnos Park. This five acre woodland coombe was originally used as an orchard space by the Victorian owners. The woodland has grown naturally over time to become a wildlife haven for many birds and animals and offers a peaceful space for those wishing to have a more natural final resting place.

We welcome all faiths, cultures, and beliefs, and offer both traditional and alternative options.



By bus: Services 1, X39, 57, 178 and 349 stop nearby


