

Arnos Vale Cemetery is a <u>filming-friendly</u> 45-acre Victorian garden cemetery with a vast array of locations available for filming from the traditional graveyard to overgrown graves brimming with wildlife, as well as a café to a gift shop, crypt to an outdoor wooded venue, and two Victorian chapels – The Anglican Chapel and the Spielman Centre, the spaces of which can be repurposed for your production.

Based in the heart of Bristol, on a main artery – the A4, our site has excellent access and is open 7 days a week. We are a run by the Arnos Vale Cemetery Trust, and can close the site to give a production the space, security and secrecy needed.




